331 The Leader of the Australian Greens (Senator Bob Brown):

To move—That the Senate—

(a) welcomes the reported decision of the Minister for Climate Change and the

Environment (Ms Tebbutt) to spend \$1.23 million on a recovery plan for

koalas, including revegetating koala habitat; and

(b) calls on the New South Wales Government to halt logging of any koala

habitat forest including that in the Bermagui region on the state's south

coast.

Only the Greens and Senator Xenophon voted for it. Labor and Liberal senators voted against it.
